



INÓSPITO Old Vines Shale White Wine

Inóspito Vinhas Velhas Xisto comes from a vineyard planted in 1915 located next to the Tua river where it enters the demarcated Douro region. The soil is of schist origin, has a north-easterly exposure and an altitude of 300 metres located on the right bank of the river in the village of Sobreira. The vineyard is made up of more than 35 grape varieties, including various types of Malvasia.

Fermentation takes place spontaneously with indigenous yeasts in new and used French oak barrels (Bertrange forest). We want it to be a wine where its texture, more aromatic character and freshness stand out.

A pure, unadulterated wine.
